The conversations in the Gospel reading of today are very brief: 'What are you looking for?' 'Where do you live?' 'They remained with him that day.' There are no crowds, no description of time, no description of the place where Jesus lived. We know that whatever happened that afternoon changed the lives of Andrew and his companion forever. John the Baptist calls Jesus "the Lamb of God" and Andrew calls him "the Messiah". The reading is an invitation to us to believe and accept Jesus as the messiah.
